



## Leadership Northwest Scholarship Application

### Criteria

- Must reside in one of the following 19 counties: Andrew, Atchison, Buchanan, Caldwell, Carroll, Clay, Clinton, Daviess, DeKalb, Gentry, Grundy, Harrison, Holt, Linn, Livingston, Mercer, Nodaway, Sullivan, and Worth
- Applicant must be a 2025 graduate of a high school located in one of the 19 counties
- Applicant must be admitted to a vocational school, community college, 4-year college, or university and enrolled in at least 6 credit hours
